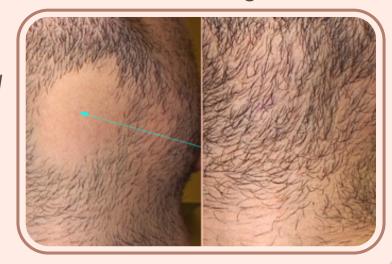

The Hair Growth Cycle

* Anagen Phase:

Active growth (2-6 years).

* Catagen Phase:

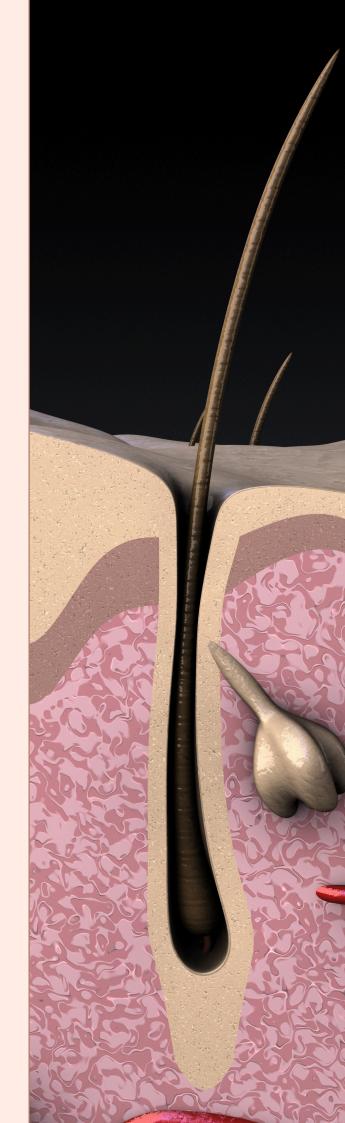
Transition phase (~2-3 weeks).

* Telogen Phase:

Resting phase (2-3 months) before shedding.

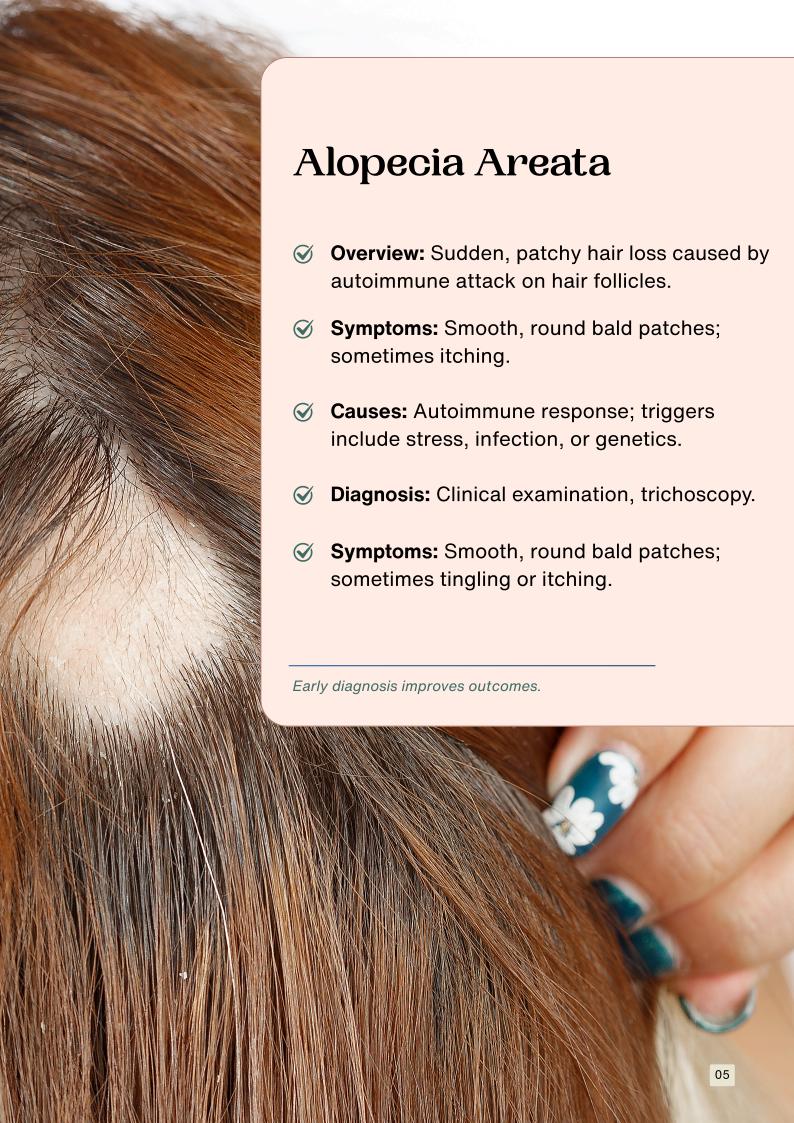
Normal shedding: Losing 50–100 hairs per day is natural.

Washing or brushing hair frequently **does not cause hair loss.** Genetics, hormones, stress, and diet play far larger roles.

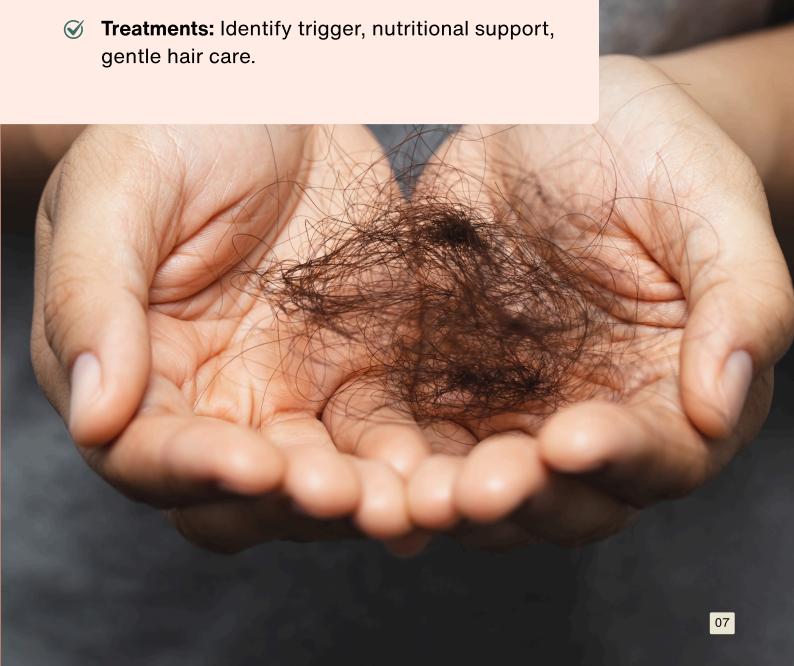


Female Pattern Hair Loss

- **Overview:** Diffuse thinning over the crown with maintained frontal hairline.
- Causes: Genetics, hormonal imbalance, thyroid disorders, PCOS.
- ▼ Treatments: Topical therapies, PRP, hormonal optimization, nutritional guidance.

Telogen Effluvium

- **Overview:** Temporary hair shedding after stress, illness, surgery, or hormonal changes.
- Symptoms: Sudden shedding across the scalp.

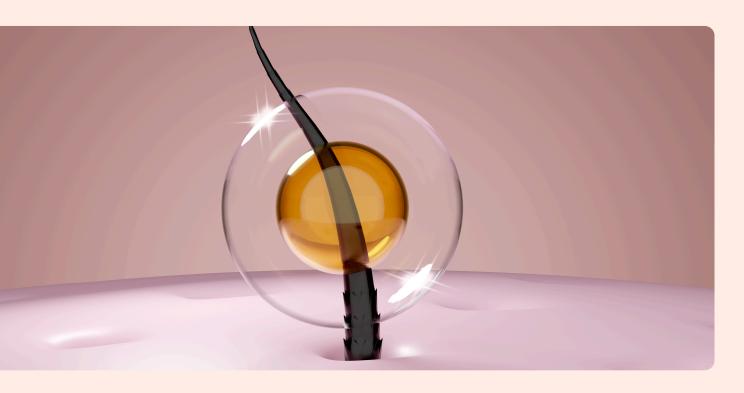




Scalp Conditions

Dandruff / Seborrheic Dermatitis / Psoriasis

- Symptoms: Flaking, itching, redness.
- ▼ Treatments: Medicated shampoos, topical treatments, lifestyle adjustments.



Hair Breakage & Texture Changes

- Causes: Chemical treatments, excessive heat, nutritional deficiencies, endocrine disorders.
- ▼ Treatments: Repair protocols, supplements, reduced chemical exposure.
